

Drop In Cervical Screening (smear) Clinic

After Visit Advice Summary

Thank you for visiting the drop in cervical screening clinic. You may have some spotting or light bleeding after your cervical screening test. This is very common and should go away after a few hours. Your results can take a couple of weeks to come back to you via letter.

You should have received leaflets about what these results mean with your letter inviting you to attend your cervical screen. However should you need further advice about this please visit:
