This leaflet provides information and guidance on how to reduce or prevent vulval irritation.

Vulval care:

Women with vulval irritation or soreness often have sensitive skin. Some simple measures in skin care can reduce or stop irritation:

- Avoid using soaps, bubble baths and shower gels. Instead use water or a soap substitute (emollient).
- Don't linger or soak in the bath for long periods of time; it dries out the skin. Having a shower is better.
- Use non-biological washing powder or liquid and avoid using fabric conditioners on your underwear and towels
- Use a separate towel for the vulval area to avoid soap residue on the towel used to dry the rest of your body getting onto your skin
- Wear non-dyed cotton underwear
- Avoid tight-fitting trousers and tights when able
- Apply emollients or barrier cream e.g. Hydromol, Dermol or Vaseline as required. Talk to your nurse about creams if you wear a pad.
- Avoid shaving and waxing. Clip pubic hair instead.
