About knee braces

There are many different knee braces available, ranging from simple elastic/neoprene pullon supports to a more complex type made of carbon fibre for sporting activities. The orthotist will select the right type for your condition. The aim of the brace is to do one or more of the following:

- Relieve pain
- Control deformity
- Support ligament damage
- Generally aid daily living

Soft knee braces

These can start with simple elastic/neoprene pull-on braces, some of which will have added support in the way of sprung bones or metal joints. They are used to help in conditions such as osteoarthritis, slight ligament strains, and kneecap (patella) misalignment. This type of knee brace has a limited life span, and may need replacing. This can be done by contacting the Surgical Appliance/Orthotic Department.

Hard knee braces

These are usually for more serious knee conditions, which require a lot of support, such as severe ligament damage, severe osteoarthritis and severe deformity. They are more difficult to use and must be fitted as instructed by the orthotist.

How do I use the knee brace?

It is important to use your knee brace as instructed by the orthotist. If you feel that the brace is no longer fitting properly, then contact the Appliance/Orthotic Department for an appointment.
