# What is a moulded spinal jacket?

The spinal jacket has been specially made to support and correct the spine. It is to be worn throughout the day and **not at night**, unless you have been specifically told to do so. Spinal jackets are made of various materials. The Orthotist will choose the best for your requirements.

# How do I wear my jacket?

It is important that the jacket is fitted as instructed by the Orthotist or the physiotherapist.

- 1. Wear a closely-fitting cotton vest or T-shirt under the jacket for comfort.
- 2. Make sure you put the jacket on correctly, positioning it so it is in the right place around the pelvis.
- Ensure that any creases from the vest or T-shirt are removed before tightening the straps.
- 4. Pull the straps up tightly as shown by the Orthotist.
- 5. If fitting the jacket to a child, use it gradually so he or she gets used to the feel of the jacket. Initially apply it for one hour to start with, then remove the jacket and vest and check for any pressure areas. If everything is all right, then build up the time by one hour a day until it is being worn for the whole day. You will need to persevere; be patient but firm.
- 6. If there are persistent areas of redness, then stop wearing the jacket and contact the Orthotic/Appliance Department for an appointment.

# How do I look after my spinal jacket?

- Keep the jacket away from direct heat as this may affect the material it is made of.
- Check that the jacket isn't getting too tight or too short in length.

- Do not wash the jacket if it is lined or made of leather. Lightly sponge with fresh water.
- Check that all the straps are in good condition. Have any broken straps replaced by the Orthotic/Appliance Department.

# What if I have a problem?
